Whilst there is no obligation to do so, it does indicate that those who participate meet the quality requirements set by the service industries and are engaging in best practice.

Benefits - Right Way Training Facility

When you participate in the Right Way program to gain industry recognition of your training facilities, you will enjoy the following benefits:



- Engagement with Service Skills Australia who, as the developers, thoroughly understand the training package. They can provide insight into the requirements of the training package.
- Consultation with current industry practitioners throughout the facility evaluation phase. These Industry Advisors will provide advice to improve your facilities, equipment and resources. The program takes a quality improvement rather than a punitive approach.
- An opportunity to engage industry based Industry Advisors after the Right Way Program has introduced them to your organisation. You may wish to engage trusted Industry Advisors to work on a consulting basis when developing or planning the use of appropriate training and assessment facilities, engaging suitable trainers and assessors and developing learning materials.
- Recognition as an RTO which operates an industry recognised Right Way Training Facility. This provides both a market advantage and provides information to state and territory government registration authorities (SRAs) that you have consulted with industry and comply with industry requirements.
- A listing in Service Skills' on-line directory of RTOs operating industry recognised Right Way training facilities. This is accessed by prospective students, their parents and employers.
- Use of the Right Way logo on your marketing and student certification documentation which identifies you as an RTO with industry recognised Right Way training facilities.
- Participation in a network of RTOs who are committed to achieving high industry standards of training set apart from the rest.

- Industry recognition of your materials as Right Way Training Resources.
- If an RTO, recognition as an operator that uses industry recognised Right Way Training Resources. This provides both a market advantage and provides information to State and Territory government registration authorities (SRAs) that you have consulted with industry and complied with industry requirements.
